REQUIREMENTS: As required by the "No Child Left Behind" legislation, paraprofessionals (Teacher's Assistants, Special Education Aides, Avid Tutors, Instructional Aides, Library Technicians, Bilingual/Cross Cultural Aides, etc.) must meet a "Highly Qualified" criterion. This is accomplished by having either: complete 2 years of study at an institution of Higher Learning (48 units or more with **official** Transcripts submitted with application), **OR** obtain an Associate's Degree or higher, **OR** demonstrated knowledge of and the ability to assist in instructing in the classroom in English, reading, writing, and math by passing the state or local assessment exam (No Child Left Behind test – NCLB).

LOCATION: Tests will be held at the East County Career Center located at 924 E. Main St., El Cajon 92021 (Corner of Mollison & Main St. – www://eccc.guhsd.net)

TIME: The test will be he given from **3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.** Bring a picture I.D. and you must arrive 5 to 10 minutes early because the test will begin at 3:00 p.m. Nobody will be admitted after that time.

SCHEDULE: The above calendar of exam dates is as follows for paraprofessionals who choose to meet the criteria through local assessment/exam.
