Allows for 180 Total Teaching Days. Allows for one faculty workday at the end of the semester and at the end of the school year. Allows for three staff development days prior to start of school. Allows for 10-day Winter Break and 5-day Spring Break. Last day of regular school will be Tuesday, June 22, 2010.

NOTE: First semester has 18 weeks and second semester has 20 weeks. Progress reporting periods are every six (6) weeks for first semester; for second semester the first progress reporting period is six (6) weeks; the second and last reporting periods are seven (7) weeks.
