Military-dependent students forced to transfer school districts are losing credit for courses completed at their former school because the courses are not aligned with the receiving district school graduation requirements.

Per directive from Dr. Randolph Ward, County Superintendent of Schools, school districts are to recognize the completed courses of a military-dependent student from the former or referring school district, even though the material taught may be different subject matter than those required by the receiving school district.
