

**GROSSMONT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT
MINUTES**

**Special Governing Board Meeting
Thursday, April 20, 2006**

I. PUBLIC (OPEN) SESSION CONVENED (8:20 p.m.)

President Kelly, with all Board Members present, convened the public meeting at 8:20 p.m. Member Nehring participated via teleconference from 1 Lake Avenue, Colorado Springs, CO; a location that was publicly noticed and available to the public.

Speakers:

Jason Lee urged the Board to approve the tentative agreement with GEA, although he felt that the district needs to make further adjustments to teacher salaries to remain competitive in the County.

IV. Action Item

MSC (Nehring/Wills) to approve the tentative agreement with the Grossmont Education Association (GEA) on contract language, salary and benefits for fiscal years 2004-2005, 2005-2006, 2006-2007, pending ratification by GEA Membership, including disclosure of major provisions of the tentative agreement between the District and the Grossmont Education Association, including costs that would be incurred by the District under the agreement for the current and subsequent fiscal years in accordance with AB 1200 and GC §3547.5.

Member Schreiber read a statement indicating her intent to make a motion to table this item. Member Nehring made the motion to table the item (seconded by Member Schreiber), stating that it was his intent to vote against his motion. The motion carried 4/1 with Member Nehring voting no. Member Kelly (seconded by Member Wills) made a motion to reconsider the previous action. The motion to reconsider carried 3/2 (Members Schreiber and Urdahl voted no). The motion to table the item (Nehring/Schreiber) failed 2/3 (Members Kelly, Nehring, and Wills voted no). After extensive discussion the original motion to approve the item passed 5/0 (preferential aye vote by Student Board Member Sarah Anderson).
